Thinking Green: Green Enterprise Development was designed by Purdue's Technical Assistance Program for manufacturers and others interested in learning how to apply sustainable, environmentally friendly practices in the workplace. To become a Green Generalist & Specialist, complete the following Green Generalist and Green Specialists modules.

Green Generalist & Specialist (8 Days)

- Day 1: Green Generalist- Green 101:** Learn green concepts, key environmental issues facing manufacturers, and the components of sustainability during this awareness and educational day.
- Day 2: Green Specialist- Dumpster Dive:** Learn fundamentals of solid waste streams and their sources by focusing on the 4Rs— Refuse, Reduce, Reuse, Recycle.
- Day 3: Green Specialist- Sustainability in Practice:** Develop the business case for implementing a comprehensive environmental management or sustainability program.
- Day 4: Green Specialist- Energy Management:** Learn how to manage energy usage and invest in energy efficiency to cut energy costs and reduce carbon footprint.
- Day 5: Green Specialist- H₂O Conserve:** Learn lower-cost and conservation principles/practices in operation and design of water systems.
- Day 6: Green Specialist- Pollution Solutions:** Learn how to improve emission control and environmental management systems, and new technologies to reduce air pollution.
- Day 7: Green Specialist- Green Chemistry:** Learn how to apply green chemistry principles and techniques throughout the business.
