This two-day internal auditor course covers the concepts of ISO 14001 and provides practical, hands-on exercises to prepare you to interpret the standard and perform internal process audits of an environmental management system (EMS).

The auditing methods taught in this course are based on the ISO guidelines for auditing: ISO 19011. You'll even get to practice your new process-auditing skills by role plays involving real-life 19011 case studies, and at the end of the second day, you'll receive a course certificate.

- Measures for implementing corrective action
- Structured steps for conducting an audit
