Energy Management Demonstration Program

Become the first Indiana Manufacturer to be nationally recognized as a leader in Energy Efficiency!

For a limited time, one Indiana manufacturer can bring US Department of Energy and Purdue University resources to their industrial facility for assistance in reducing energy use and carbon emissions. These resources include training and coaching to implement the forthcoming international energy management standard, ISO 50001. By participating, your facility will be among a select group of facilities prepared to pursue certification through Superior Energy Performance, a forthcoming ANSI-accredited energy management certification program.

The Program:

The Energy Management Demonstration Program rolls three U.S. Department of Energy Programs into one larger 18 month program.

Those programs are:

1. Save Energy Now LEADER - Participating companies sign a pledge to reduce their energy intensity by 25% in 10 years.



2. ISO 50001 Energy Management Standard implementation - Participating companies will receive assistance and training to implement the forthcoming ISO standard for energy management. Compliance to this standard will become important in the future as companies require their supply chains to be in compliance. ISO 50001 will also help companies better prepare for any future government regulations of emissions and power consumption.

3. Superior Energy Performance - This program is an ANSI-accredited plant certification program that will be launched in 2011. By participating in the Energy Management Demonstrations Program, your company will be prepared to be one of the first nationally recognized energy leaders. Participating companies will receive:

- Three 2.5 day workshops to implement ISO 50001 and meet the Superior Energy Performance criteria
- Monthly one-on-one coaching by an energy consultant
- Monthly web-based seminars
- Save Energy Now LEADER resources including assessments, assistance to develop an energy baseline, and more.

Benefits:

- Receive assistance to develop a plan to reduce your plants energy use and cost by 5 – 15% over 3 years.
- Your company will save money and will be better prepared to meet any future customer or government energy and emissions requirements.

Required Commitment:

- **The participating companies must have:**
 1. Senior-level commitment to energy management
 2. At least one certified management system in place (ISO 9001, ISO 14001, etc.)
 3. A willingness to sign the DOE Save Energy Now LEADER pledge to reduce energy intensity by 25% over 10 years
 4. A commitment to pursue Superior Energy Performance certification
- **Participation in the program is free of charge**
- **Companies participating are responsible for:**
 1. Travel expenses to the 3 workshops
 2. Internal staff time to implement the program
 3. Capital improvements needed to meet the goals
 4. Certification costs for the Superior Energy Performance program (estimated to be between \$6,000 to \$20,000 depending on the size of the plant and the type of audit)
